Key Decisions and Actions	The Board continued discussions around 'joining the dots' and identifying those who are at greater risk of health deterioration from Covid.
	Following on from a presentation delivered by Ceri Mansell around the Respiratory Steering Group, it was clear that the Board are passionate in supporting this work and agreed that some of the work aligns with the identification of those who are vulnerable during the winter.
	The Board heard of the Morecambe Bay neighbourhood working model lead by Dr Andy Knox and were informed that a team to team involving colleagues from this board will be arranged in hopes of adopting a new way of working.
	A positive update was presented to the Board relating to the CATCH programme. Strong collaborative working has ensured progress on short term actions .
	The key decisions taken from this meeting included;
	 A collaborative review between LTHTR and LSCFT needs to take place regarding the prioritisation and deployment of Occupational Therapists.
	 A meeting to be coordinated, building on the work around Respiratory and the Vulnerable Patient list using a 4x4 matrix to identify those who are most critically vulnerable with clarity on the support to be offered.
