



## **ICP Key Messages**

Key Decisions and Actions	The Board heard a brief update around the work known as the 'digital front door'. The work is designed to hold and share information across Health, Social Care and Community settings.
	The Resource Committee Senior Lead provided a brief update to the Committee on the NHSE/I paper around its view of the strategic and operational direction of system working. The Board noted that the paper provides insight as to what phase 4 will look like across the NHS and the involvement of wider partnerships through ICS's and ICP's. Recognition of the positive work ongoing within the ICP was noted. It is important to now begin to leverage those changes across the partnership for the benefit of the population.
	The Board received an update on the Frailty pathway. Information from the pilot phases suggest that 65% of patients are discharged from the acute frailty assessment unit with an average length of stay under 3 days. The aim is for stays to be under 2 days, though it was noted that bed day savings need to be quantified. The Committee are happy that the next steps are heading in the right direction to continue with.
	The Resource Committee strategic lead provided a presentation of a draft Appraisal Process paper. It was agreed that further development is required, particularly around criteria and the inclusion of an appendices. Members concurred that the Frailty pathway scheme would be a good example to test through the process; this will be developed and presented within January's meeting.
